SHOW RULES

- The judge's decision is final
- Hard hats with harness required for all juniors. A.S.T.M./SEI approved hard hats are recommended. Hard hats must be worn at all times while mounted on the show grounds with the exception of western riders.
- Current negative coggins required for entry
- Exhibitors ride at their own risk
- Proper attire is required in order to be judged. Chaps are optional in all western classes
- Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve will be awarded in each division. Points will be awarded as follows: 1st-7, 2nd-5, 3rd-4, 4th-3, 5th-2, and 6th-1. Champion-2 points, Reserve Champion-1 point
- The Show Officials and Equestrian Center Staff reserve the right to refuse any entry, to change, combine, cancel, split classes or change officials
- Kelly's Ford Equestrian Center and it's employees and volunteers are not responsible for any accident or loss which may occur on the show grounds
- Schooling is permitted in the outdoor ring until 9:00 a.m. and during the lunch break
- All dogs must be kept on leashes or left at home. No exceptions.

## HAVE FUN!

**HUNTER SHORT STIRRUP.**— Open to riders 12 and under as of 12/1/08. May not cross enter into classes where jumps exceed 18”.

**STUDENT EQ.** – Open to riders in their first or second year of showing O/F at 2’ or higher as of 12/01/08

**HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE** – Open to all horses. Adult/ Junior will split if more than 3 or more in each section.

**LOW HUNTER** – Open to all. Adults may ride ponies. Fences 2’ or 2’6”.

**GREEN HUNTER** – Open to ponies in their first year of showing and horses in their first or second year of showing. Ponies must be ridden by juniors. Fences 2’ for small/med. ponies, 2’3” for large ponies, and 2’6” for horses.

**KF/VHSA PONY EQ.** –Open to juniors mounted on ponies. Fences 2’ for small, 2’3” for med., 2’6” for large. At least ¼ of the class will be asked to return to show at a walk, trot, and canter, and to perform additional tests at the judge’s discretion.

**PONY HUNTER** – Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Fences will be 2’ for small, 2’3” for medium and 2’6” for large ponies.

**KF/VHSA CHILDREN’S/ADULT AMATEUR EQ.** – Open to juniors and adult amateurs mounted on horses. Fences 2’6” or 3’. At least ¼ of the class will be asked to return to show at a walk, trot, and canter, and to perform additional tests at the judge’s discretion.

**CHILDREN’S/ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER** – Open to juniors or amateurs on horses. Fences 2’6” or 3’. Division will be split if there are 6 children and 6 adult entries.

**WORKING HUNTER** – Open to all. Adults may ride ponies. Fences 3’.

## DIRECTIONS

*From Warrenton:* Route 29 South to Elkwood. Turn left on Kelly’s Ford Road (Route 674). Go 5 miles to Edward’s Shop Road (Route 620). Then go ½ mile on Edward’s Shop Road. Kelly’s Ford Equestrian Center is on left – turn in third entrance.

*From Charlottesville:* Route 29 North to Elkwood. Turn right on Kelly’s Ford Road (Route 674). Go 5 miles to Edward’s Shop Road (Route 620). Then go ½ mile on Edward’s Shop Road. Kelly’s Ford Equestrian Center is on left – turn in third entrance.

*From Fredericksburg:* Take Route 3 West past Lake of the Woods. Just past Germanna Community College at the Shell station, turn right on Yellow Bottom Road (Route 620). Go approximately 2.5 miles to stop sign and turn left on Ely’s Ford Road (Route 610). Go approximately ½ mile and turn right back on Edward’s Shop Road (Route 620). Go 5 miles (including over 1 Lane Bridge) and turn right into first entrance at The Inn at Kelly’s Ford.

## CLASS RULES

**HALTER CLASSES** –Class #1 The horse is judged based on its conformation.

**LEADLINE/WALK – English or Western** Classes #2 and 3 open to riders 7 and under as of 12/1/08. Class #2 judged 50% eq. and 50% suitability. In class #3 spotters may walk with horse with no leadline attached. May not cross enter.

**ADULT BEGINNER – English or Western.** For riders 19 and over in their first or second year of showing. To be judged on Equitation. Riders may not cross enter into anything but pleasure classes.

**OPEN WESTERN CLASSES** – Open to all in western tack.

**PRE-SHORT STIRRUP EQ.** – Open to riders 10 and under as of 12/1/08. May not cross enter into classes that canter or jump.
